Dear Dmitry,

Thank you for your message and the question.

Targeted fishing for *Beryx splendens* (FAO code - BYS) is currently regulated under the general CMMs as well as CMM03-2020 (Bottom Fishing) and CMM03a-2020 (Deepwater species – note that the catch limit for “all other target and non-target species”, in the evaluated area, does include *B. splendens*).

I believe that there are 2 modus operandi available for flag States who are not currently fishing for *B. splendens*:

1. If the fishing is intended to be conducted within one of the Management Areas defined in Annex 4 of CMM03-2020 (and will use a related fishing method ie bottom trawl, midwater trawl or bottom line) then the process described in paragraph 20 of CMM03-2020 should be followed.
2. Alternatively, If the fishing is intended to be conducted outside the aforementioned Management Areas (or would use a different method), then the flag State should follow the process described in CMM13-2020 (Exploratory fisheries) as this CMM is also applicable for new fisheries.

I trust this clarification is helpful.

Subject: Regulatory measures

Dear Craig,

In accordance with Article 1 of the Convention it is possible to manage fisheries in relation to squid through the establishment of Conservation Measures.

However, the SPRFMO Commission has not taken specific regulatory measures regarding *Beryx splendens* until now. At the same time, there are general regulatory measures adopted by SPRFMO Commission for fishing vessels that operate in the Convention Area. In this regard, clarifications would be appreciated by the Secretariat regarding the modus operandi of the flag State in case of intention to fish for *Beryx splendens* in the Convention Area.
