China Overseas Fisheries Association (COFA) and Shanghai Ocean University (SHOU) were authorized by the Chinese government to jointly undertake the CJM and GIS fishing activities data collection. The CJM fishing activities data were submitted to the Secretariat in accordance with requirements of CMM02-2018. But it is difficult for Chinese squid jigging vessels to meet the requirements of CMM 02-2018 in such a short time, because there are hundreds of squid jigging vessels fishing in the South Pacific area, it needs more time and effort to collect all the data required by the CMM from the vessels. Even so, we have made significant progress in collecting squid data compared with last year, we have provided the fishing activity data, transshipment data for 80% of Chinese squid jigging vessels. China will continue working on the improvement of the squid data collection so as to meet requirements of
CMM 02-2018 completely.
