The observer program of Chinese Taipei's Jumbo flying squid fishery is still under development. Till now, the National Observer Training Program has been revised in March 2019 to include the observer program for squid fisheries. The working items for observers onboard squid vessels, such as domestic regulations, fishing gear and method, squid species identification, squid sampling and measurement and bycatch issues, were included in the training course. A total of ten observers has finished the training course in April 2019, who are capable to conduct the duty on squid-jigging vessels as well as longline vessels.

Data verification

Our squid jigging vessels are required to daily fill in their logbooks and report catch data through the electronic logbook system. Data will be delivered to the commissioned professional institution for compilation, debugging, analysis and storage in database.

Fishing vessels intending to conduct at-sea or in-port transshipment are required to obtain prior approval from the Fisheries Agency (FA).



After the completion of transshipment, the vessel owner is required to submit the transshipment declaration to the FA within prescribed time. Transshipment information is incorporated into the Deep Sea Fisheries Management System (DSFMS). Such information will be used as criteria to review the application for catch document and certificate.

In case fishing vessels intend to conduct landing in domestic ports or foreign ports, the vessels are also required to obtain prior approval from the FA. After the completion of landing, the owners are required to submit landing declaration to the FA within prescribed time.

The FA will send inspectors randomly to monitor the landing of vessels that have applied for landing in domestic ports; for in-port transshipment or landing in foreign ports, depends on the case the inspection is commissioned by the independent third party.

For both landing and transshipment, the owners are required to submit copies of invoices on sale of catches to the FA. Such information is also incorporated in the DSFMS.

According to the Act for Distant Water Fisheries, any person with the nationality of the Republic of China shall not engage in or support IUU fishing, such as participating in joint fishing with, transhipping with or supplying any fishing vessel listed on the IUU fishing vessel lists of the international fisheries organizations or stateless vessel; or trading (purchasing, selling, marketing, etc.) or processing catches or fisheries products with the knowledge that such catches or fisheries products originate from catches caught by fishing vessel listed in the IUU fishing vessel lists of the international fisheries organizations.

Distant water fisheries operators or distant water fisheries employees commit any of the aforementioned serious infringements are to be fined between 1 million to 30 million New Taiwan Dollars, and the fishing license



may be suspended for up to 2 years or be revoked; such employees are to be fined between 200 thousand and 6 million New Taiwan Dollars, and the Fishing Vessel Crew Identifications and the Certificate of Fishing Vessel Officers may be suspended for up to 2 years or be revoked.

Along with the abovementioned penalties, the catches or fisheries products caught, transhipped, purchased or sold, or sold on assignment, or fishing gears involved may also be confiscated, regardless of the ownership.

If the fines are less than the value of seized fishery products, the perpetrator would instead be fined up to five times of the value of the seized products, and repeat violations are subject to more severe punishment.

Fishing vessels involved in IUU fishing will be denied from port entry. In case that there ' s sufficient evidence indicating that the fishing vessel has conducted or supported IUU fishing after the inspection, the competent such fishing vessel will be denied from unloading, transshipment, packaging, processing of catches, refueling, supplying, maintenance or using other port services, and prohibit such fishing vessel from leaving the port.

According to the Act for Distant Water Fisheries, any applicant who applies for the issuance of distant water fisheries permit has any circumstances listed in Article 7, the issuance of the distant water fisheries permit shall be denied. In any of the listed circumstances in Article 8, the FA shall deny the issuance of the distant water fisheries permit. For the distant water fisheries permit that has been issued, the FA shall adjust, limit, or revoke.

Para 3: Describe the measures you have taken to ensure that you are able to take effective enforcement actions against the owners of vessels flying your flag should the need arise.

According to the Act for Distant Water Fisheries, the Ordinance and other relevant regulations, when owners, captains and other officers of Taiwan's fishing vessels violate the Act, the Ordinance and other relevant regulations, they will be subject to punishment, which may include fine, suspension and revocation of the fishing licenses of the vessel owners, and the professional certificates of the captains in question. For the owners, captains and other officers who commit the same violations the punishment is much more severe. The case may also be forwarded to the judicial authority for investigation and prosecution, and if convicted, they are liable to imprisonment for a term of up to three years, in addition to detention, and/or fine.
