Standard for Landings Data

With regard to the fishing, reefer or factory vessels flying their flag and fishing for or transporting non-highly migratory fishery resources in the Area-

Participants are to:

- 1. Collect data on an individual landings basis.
- 2. Collect the following fields of data:
 - a) Current vessel flag
 - b) Name of vessel
 - c) Type of vessel (carrier vessel, fishing vessel, factory vessel)
 - d) Registration number of vessel
 - e) International radio call sign (if any)
 - f) Lloyd's / IMO number (if allocated)
 - g) Date entered SPRFMO Area
 - h) Date exited SPRFMO Area
 - i) Landing date
 - j) Area catch taken (e.g. FAO area¹)
 - k) Landing Type (e.g. transhipment or not)
 - I) Country of Landing (standard ISO 3-alpha country codes)
 - m) Port/Point of Landing
 - n) Landed State* by species (see footnote)
 - o) Landed (live) weight by species
 - p) Containers Type by species
 - q) Containers Number by species
 - r) Containers Content weight by species

*Landed state:

This means the 'state' in which the fish was landed. States may include 'live' (fish has not been
