Provision of 2007 Vessel GT for fishing pelagic stocks in the area

Paragraph 1 of the Pelagic fisheries section of the Interim Measures requires that Participants notify the Interim Secretariat of the total level of gross tonnage (GT) recorded in the high seas of the South Pacific (the Area) during 2007 and that Participants verify the effective presence of the vessels in the area during 2007 through VMS records, catch reports, port calls or other means with information that the interim Secretariat would have access to such information upon request.

The attached table shows those participants who have provided some or all of the required data. You should note that some vessel sizes have been provided as GRT instead of GT.
