Dear Mr. Luis Molledo,

Thank you for your dedication in revising the VMS CMM, please find below Chinese Taipei's comments on the draft.

On paragraph 16 and 17, as there're some difficulties on implementation of official seal issued by Flag State, such as the environment at sea may cause damage of seal or the maintenance issue. We suggest to discuss all relevant issues on the implementation before this CMM put into practice.

Seconds, it is good to have a positive progress that in paragraph 23 indicating both Members and CNCPs are able to request VMS data equally, however the content of a) and b) is actually related to CMM 11-2015 Boarding and Inspection Procedures which is not yet developed, we suggest to delete these two subparagraphs for now and discuss it again after the Commission has reach consensus on the development of CMM 11-2015.

Last, paragraph 23 d) is very similar to relevant VMS measures of WCPFC and it shall be noted that the Convention water of WCPFC includes EEZ of the Costal State and the Convention water of SPRFMO is only high seas (excludes the EEZ of Costal State). Therefore, we're concerned if it is appropriate to empower the Costal State to get VMS data of 100 nautical miles from their EEZ while vessels operating in the Convention water of competence and already under the surveillance of the Flag State and the Commission. We suggest to delete paragraph 23d), or replaced by "maintaining situational awareness of high seas areas adjacent to and not more than 100 nautical miles from their EEZ while receive port entry request".
